**Call for Applications for awards for the 2019-2020 academic year**

**Purpose of the award**

- To support adult women students who are pursuing their academic goals.
- To reduce the student's amount of loans, work study, or personal/family contribution, and not reduce any college or university grant. The award will equal the cost of tuition and fees for one or more courses up to a maximum of \$5,000, depending upon the institution attended. Preference will be given to students working on their first AA or BA/BS.

**Who may apply**

A candidate must be:

- female, age 25 or above
- resident of one of the 29 towns served by the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving:

- enrolled in the 2019-2020 academic year as an undergraduate pursuing an AA or a BA/BS degree at one of the following colleges or universities:

Manchester Community College	Trinity College	University of Saint Joseph
- enrolled either on a part-time or full-time basis
- have a GPA of 2.5 or above
- have completed 15 hours or the equivalent of academic work by the end of the 2018 fall semester
- eligible for financial assistance as determined by the 2019-2020 federal Student Aid Report (SAR) and by submission of your 2018 federal tax return

**Criteria for evaluation**

Academic record, personal statement, faculty recommendation, and financial need are considered in choosing the recipients. An interview may be required.

**Two ways to complete an application**

**Choose either paper or online:**

1. **Paper** application - printed from [www.towncounty.com](http://www.towncounty.com)
  - If you complete a paper application, you must submit **TWO COPIES** of each of the following:
    1. Completed and signed Town and County Club Fund Scholarship Application
    2. Unofficial transcripts from ALL colleges attended within the last five years
    3. Copy of all pages of your 2019-2020 federal Student Aid Report (SAR)
    4. Copy of your 2018 federal tax return
    5. Reference from a faculty member with whom you have had at least one course
    6. Personal statement (see IV, p. 2 of application)
2. **Online** application – go to [www.hfpg.org/scholarships](http://www.hfpg.org/scholarships) and type Town and County into search bar; click scholarship name; follow instructions
  - If you are completing an online application, all materials must be uploaded in the application.

**Deadline:**

- **Paper** applications and materials must be received by February 22, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. by the Scholarship Committee of the Town and County Club, 22 Woodland Street, Hartford, CT 06105.
- **Online** applications must be submitted online by **February 22, 2019 at 11:45 p.m.**

**Decisions:** Applicants will be notified by May 1, 2019. Awards are for the 2019-20 academic year.
